#### STATUS OF ROADS IN THE COUNTRY

**Hon. Joseph Muigai:** Madam Temporary Speaker I want to lay a paper which originated from the Minister of Public works. This is an exercise that is done by the National Government but concerns a survey that is usually done to establish the status of roads around the Country and the distance in terms of number of kilometers covered. The last time this was done was in 2002 and at the time it was estimated that the road network was around 164,000kms as at now it is estimated that it could be well over 250,000kms. However the estimates are not confirmed and this prompts a survey to be carried out to establish the number of kilometers so far. Most importantly is also to establish the width of the roads because at the time the roads that were looked into measured 9 metres and above but now what is to be done covers roads that are that size and not less than 4 metres.

I wish to table before this House a document for noting by Hon. Members.

It contains information on proposed road inventory and conditions survey. The document also contains therein among other things the objective of the proposed land survey which is

1. Establish an inventory and condition of the narrow roads network in Kenya which is currently not captured in the Kenya roads board or inventory conditions survey data base.
2. Those roads assigned numbers integrate the new data into the existing roads inventory and conditions database
3. Collect roads conditioned data for the classified roads network that is 160,860kms and up to date Kenya roads and inventory and conditions geo data base.

Inventory will be conducted in western, coastal and central zones by the Government of Kenya in collaboration with Australian consulting firms. All Hon. Members are requested by the Chairperson Committee on Transport and Public works to afford the consultant the necessary assistance where necessary.

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Members when this exercise will be going on you may be called upon to help the consultant in identifying and giving necessary information as far as those roads are concerned and you are called upon to cooperate with them so that we can get accurate data as far as the roads are concerned.
