### PETITION

#### PETITION FROM RUTH WANGUI KAMAU FOR NONPAYMENT OF SALARY

**The Deputy Speaker** (Hon. James Twei): Thank you, we have a Petition from a petitioner called Ruth Wangui Kamau of box 71 Nakuru and her ID numbers is 8615568. It reads-

I am Ruth Wangui Kamau a Kenyan citizen and resident of Nakuru County, working with the ministry of Medical Services at Nakuru Level 5 Hospital formally Rift Valley General Hospital.

Nonpayment of salary- I am a senior nursing officer and I was granted unpaid leave of two years with effect from 1<sup>ST</sup> October 2012 to 30<sup>TH</sup> September 2014 with an extension of one year from 1<sup>ST</sup> October 2014 and including September 2015. Attached reference letter 1990104365/55 dated 6<sup>TH</sup> December 2012 and 1990104365/64 dated 13<sup>TH</sup> November 2015 respectively.

I reported back on duty on 1<sup>ST</sup> October 2015 as per the attached letter reference number 19904365/91 on expiry of the contract since that time i.e. October 2015 I have been working and I have never received any salary.

Effort made to address the issue- the matter was presented to Nakuru County Public Service Board through the Chief Officer Health Services, Nakuru County on November 2015 reference number 1990104365/12.

The county public service board granted an approval for me to be introduced to the county pay roll reference number NCPSB STAFF VOLUME 36. Despite the above effort the issue has not succeeded to date. The issue being petitioned is not pending in any court of law.

My humble request to the County Assembly- since I resumed in October 2015, I have been working faithfully in Nakuru Provincial General Hospital without any salary.

My son was in college and I had paid for two semesters up to August 2016 but unfortunately I was not able to pay for the last semester and was forced to defer, the reason being I had exhausted all my savings.

I am humbly requesting the County Assembly to consider my case so that I am paid my dues since life has become difficult for and my son because we are depending on friends to lend us money for our daily upkeep, please consider my request.
