APPROPRIATIONS BILL NO. 1 OF 2017

(SECOND REMANDING)

Hon. Moses Kamau: Thank you Madam Temporary Speaker, I beg to move the Motion;-

THAT the Nakuru County Appropriations Bill No. 1 of 2017 be now read a Second Time.

Hon. Beatrice Wambugu: I am a Member of the Committee on Budget and Appropriations and I stand to second the Motion.

(Question proposed)

Hon. Moses Kamau: This Motion introduces how the resources will be spent in the recurrent and the development expenditure as highlighted and therefore I am calling upon the House to debate by looking whether those votes heads both for recurrent and development expenditure are in order, but I am sure they are in order and I request the House to adopt.

The Temporary Speaker (Hon. Eunice Muriithi): Thank you, any other Member?

Hon. Rosemary Kamau: I am a Member of the Committee on Budget and Appropriations and when I look at this document I can see all that we captured in the morning is here and I am supporting it.

Hon. Beatrice Wambugu: Asante sana Mheshimiwa Spika wa Muda, nasimama kunga mkono huu mjadala, kwanza kwa sababu tumeona wale wauguzi ambao walikua wameajiriwa kwa kandarasi ya muda tumeweza kuangalia pesa zao na zikawekwa kwa pesa ambazo zitakua kwa 2017/18. Hizo pesa zimeondolewa kwa laini zingine ambazo tuliona zinafaa kwa sababu tunahaja na wauguzi wetu ili waweze kurudi kazini na kwa hayo naunga mkono nikisema wakati tunaelekea kumaliza muda wetu, ile serikali itakuja baadae iweze kuchukulia hii kazi kwa nguvu kwa sababu tumekua na shida mingi sana wakati tunaweka pesa kwa bajeti kisha unapata zile pesa zinaenda kutumika mahali pengine.

Kamam vile saa hii tunafahamu kuwa kuna enforcement officers ambao wameajiriwa nasi kama bunge hili tunasema hatujaweka pesa za kulipa hawa maafisa na badala ya hiyo tungependa hizo pesa kwanza zitatue mashida ya wauguzi ambao kandarasi yao niya muda waajiriwe.

Pia tukiangalia upande wa mazingira, tumekuwa na shida sana kwa casuals tungeliomba ya kwamba pesa ambayo inakuja ishughulikie wafanyikazi wale kwa njia ya haki. Asante sana.

Hon. Hillary Korir: Thank you Madam Temporary Speaker, as much as I want to support this Motion we all know there is a cap from the National Government talking about the expenditure in development versus recurrent.

If we can think clearly from what we have here we can see that we are barely at the minimum of the development funds and I think we need to raise development funds at least to be as high as 20 per cent above the current figure so that in the future, we ensure that this county of Nakuru will have a lot compared to the current scenario where we are having maybe 70 percent for the recurrent expenditure. I think going forward even in the coming regime, I would request that this honorable House considers this so that Nakuru County will dwell much in ensuring that they reach the apex of development.
